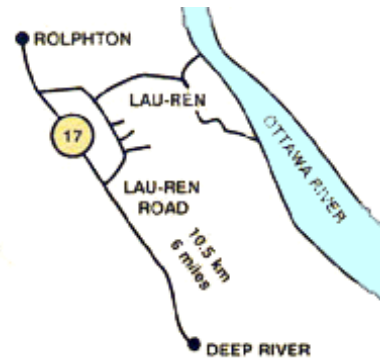

IMPORTANT ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE NOTES

Check In Times:

Six-day camps must check in between 2:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. on Sunday.

Tadpole – campers must check in between 10:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. on Thursday, July 6th.

Check Out Times:

Outgoing campers must be picked up between 10:30 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. on Saturday.

Camp Lau-Ren is not responsible for incoming campers before registration on arrival day or for outgoing campers after 11:00 a.m. Saturday.

Please – no visitors during the camp period. Phone calls to the campers are not permitted.

Please see our website at www.camplau-ren.com to find out what to bring to camp and what not to bring to camp. On Sunday afternoon and Saturday morning, the Camp Store, which is located in the Resource Centre, is open to sell T-shirts, sweatshirts, caps, barbecue wands and water bottles. Campers can also pre-order camp apparel which will be available for pick-up at check in (see Registration Form).

Camp Lau-Ren Refund Policy: There are no refunds for cancellations for any reason (including medical) after May 31st or for campers failing to attend. \$75.00 administration fee for cancellations prior to May 31st.

Camp Lau-Ren has a "No Nit" policy. All campers will be checked for head lice upon arrival at camp. Any camper found to have nits/head lice will be sent home and will not be allowed to return to camp for seven days. The registration fee will be applied to a future camp that summer or applied to the registration fee for a 2018 camp (minus \$75 administration fee).
